

Get Credit Toward Your Master's Degree from Sherman Block SLI, Command College, FBINA or FBI-LEEDA

The M.S. in Law Enforcement & Public Safety Leadership (MS-LEPSL) program at the University of San Diego has developed new transfer credit opportunities for graduates of FBI-LEEDA's Trilogy Training, California P.O.S.T.'s Sherman Block Supervisory Leadership Institute and the San Diego County Regional Leadership Institute. These partnerships are an extension of the existing transfer credit arrangements the program has in place for graduates of FBI National Academy and P.O.S.T. Command College. Graduates of these programs can apply 6-12 units of graduate transfer credit toward the completion of the nationally-ranked MS-LEPSL program.

USD's 100% online MS-LEPSL program is the choice of chiefs and command staff professionals because of its contemporary curriculum, a focus on developing ethics-centric leadership skills, and a flexible format that adapts to the needs of law enforcement professionals. The University is also offering ten \$2,500 scholarships for new students. The deadline to apply for the scholarship is February 14th, with classes starting in May.
