

KEY EXECUTIVE FORUM PROGRAMME

PURPOSE:

The Key Executive Forum programme is an opportunity for your senior executive(s) to experience share and learn with peers in the same structured and safe Forum Mindset environment that you know in EO.

You can leverage this professional development opportunity to build your leadership teams and transfer value immediately back to your company.

STRUCTURE

Key Executive Forums (KEFs) follow the same design that member Forums follow:

- Monthly 3-4 hour Forum meetings
- Forum members select time, date and location
- Discussion focused on business
- Constitution and Forum Mindset



QUALIFICATIONS

KEFs are for senior executives in EO member companies who fulfill CFO, HR, CMO or COO responsibilities. More than one executive from each member company is allowed, however, they will be placed in separate executive Forums.

KEF members may remain in their Forum as long as their EO member remains a chapter member in good standing.

PROCESS

Forum chairs support KEFs with planning, insights and updates and also manage their Forum placement process.

- All KEF members must be Forum-trained by an official EO Forum facilitator.
- KEF moderators must be moderator-trained through chapter or regional moderator training.
- KEF trainings must be scheduled by the chapter through the scheduling tool (eonetnetwork.org/member/forum/request-forum-training) and have a minimum of six attendees.
- KEF may hire EO Forum facilitators for retreats, workshops or custom programmes.
- KEF can grow up to 10 members maximum.
- KEF members are members of Forums, but do not have full EO membership benefits.

PROGRAMME COSTS

- Forum trainings must have a minimum of six people per training and cost US\$250 per executive, billed to chapters.
- Moderator training cost will be determined by the annual Forum Committee budget.
- Travelling to attend in-person Forum trainings will be at KEF member's own expense. Forum chair and chapter staff may assist in organizing their attendance at other chapter trainings.
- Annual fees for both participation in a Forum or renewing KEF membership is at the discretion of each chapter.
