


NSR Production

Projects Completed




Title V Production

New APD Tools and Procedures

- STEERs ePermits must be used for Title V as of January 1, 2023.
- Incomplete process for Standard Permits.
- Aggregate Product Operations Workbook releasing May 2023.

Title V Petitions and Objections

- EPA has issued orders, granting objections in whole or part, on Title V permits that received petitions.
- EPA has objected during the 45-day review period.
- EPA orders/objections are focused on:
 - NSR monitoring
 - Use of Confidential Business Information
 - PBR codification
 - Other concerns

Rule Updates

Non-Rule Standard Permit for Concrete Batch Plants

- Revise the standard permit to include an updated AQA, revised operating requirements, set-back limitations, and restrictions on operating hours.
- Important Dates:
 - Notice published on April 14, 2023
 - Public hearing on May 18, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.
 - Hearing will be held virtually and in-person.
 - Close of comment period is June 14, 2023.

Rule Updates

- MSW Landfill State Plan and Rule Updates
 - Update rule and state plan to implement the 2016 and 2019 landfill emission guidelines.
- Ch. 116 Amendment
 - Clarify the requirements applicable to the holder of a registration under the Standard Permit for CBP when the permit holder intends to move the registered CBP to a new location on the site.
- Quadrennial Rule Reviews of all air permitting rules in 30 TAC.

Federal Rule Updates

- Project Emissions Accounting (PEA)
 - Proposed approval posted in federal register March 6, 2023.
 - Allowed reductions to be considered in step 1 of major NSR applicability determinations for existing major sources.
 - Comments were due April 5, 2023.

Federal Rule Updates

- Reconsideration of Fugitive Emissions Rule
 - Posted in Federal Register October 22, 2022.
 - Proposal would require all existing major stationary sources to consider fugitives in considering whether a modification constitutes a major modification rather than just named sources.
 - Does not change rules for major source determination.
 - Extended comment period ended February 14, 2023.

Federal Rule Updates

- Proposed reconsideration of PM_{2.5} standard
 - Posted in Federal Register January 27, 2023.
 - Proposal revises annual standard by lowering the level from 12.0 µg/m³ to within the range of 9.0 to 10.0 µg/m³.
 - Comments were due by March 28, 2023.

Sunset Review

- The TCEQ is under Sunset review as required by Texas Government Code, Section 325.007.
- SB1397 and HB1505 were filed for the continuation and functions of the TCEQ.
- Changes that could impact Air Permits
- Status of the Bills
