College in the High School

The College in the High School program is offered through the Office of Continuing Education at Central Washington University and Eastern Washington University. It allows students to take rigorous college courses while attending their local high school. Classes are taught by qualified high school instructors who have been approved as adjunct instructors.

All classes are the same challenging courses offered at the university. The credits earned, if applied at CWU, EWU, or transferred to another institution, should enhance students' progress toward a degree, reduce the cost of college and strengthen their chances of being accepted to their college of choice.

- Students can accelerate their academic studies by earning college credit while attending high school without giving up their experience.
- Students have the opportunity to experience college-level work in a familiar environment.
- Completing rigorous high school coursework and earning college credit can strengthen the student's college application and help meet basic college and university requirements.
- Students applying to CWU before high school graduation will be given the \$500 Early Scholar Tuition Waiver, provided they earned a 3.00 cumulative GPA or higher in their CWU courses.
- The undergraduate CWU application fee will be waived for students participating in the CWU CiHS program.
- Students can earn up to 15 CWU or EWU credits (or a combination thereof) *per term* in high schools where sufficient classes are offered.
