




# **Efficiency Of The Licensing Process**


**Application Type** 

**Application and all required** documents received. *Timeline: 30-60 days* 






#### **Number of Applications Reviewed For Approval By Year\***



**Executive Director** and Board President review for approval. Approval: 10-45 days

Endorsement



**Additional documentation** related to discipline or other possible concerning matters may be requested for review.

**Application reviewed by Executive Director for approval** to be placed on next monthly **Board meeting.** 

After review Executive **Director may request license** applicant to appear before **Board in person to** explain discipline or other circumstances in his/her professional or personal history.

Application placed on agenda as a separate item for Board to consider and possibly interview applicant at Meeting. Applicant may bring personal attorney.

**Executive Director submits to Board Members via secure data** base system all application documents for review before each Board meeting.

> **Application placed on** consent agenda at Monthly Board Meeting. Meeting is dark in July.



In November 2019, the Legislative Commission approved the Board's proposed regulation, LCB R011-19, which reduces by \$100, most licensing fees. License fee reductions went into effect beginning January 1, 2020.



After Board approval, license activated following day.

After Board denial, applicant may reapply-currently no timeline implemented.
