Some example questions for post-test surveys.

Remember, if you can watch the participant/user as they work with the system, ask them to talk through their thought process as they navigate your site.

Agreement with the following statements

Rate your level of agreement with each of the following statements on a scale from 1 to 5 (you can use the likert scale https://www.surveymonkey.com/mp/likert-scale)

- 1. The homepage is attractive.
- 2. The overall site is attractive.
- 3. The site's graphics are pleasing.
- 4. The site has a good balance of graphics versus text.
- 5. The colors used throughout the site are attractive.
- 6. The typography (lettering, headings, titles) is attractive.
- 7. The homepage's content makes me want to explore the site further.
- 8. It is easy to find my way around the site.
- 9. I would feel confident using this site even if there was no one around to tell me what to do as I go.
- 10. I would feel confident using this site if I could call someone for help if I got stuck.
- 11. I can get to information quickly.

3. What was the worst thing about [x]?

• Get more specific feedback about the features that aren't working well with your site.

4. If you could make one significant change to this [x], what change would you make?

• This open-ended question is a good way to gather constructive feedback and ideas for future iterations.

5. How would you compare [x] to [competitor or previous experience]?

- This is an opportunity to see how different details of your website stack up against your competitors in the eyes of users.
- 6. If you had to give the site a grade, from A to F, where A was exemplary and F was failing, what grade would you give it, and why?
- 7. Name three words or characteristics that describe this Web site.
