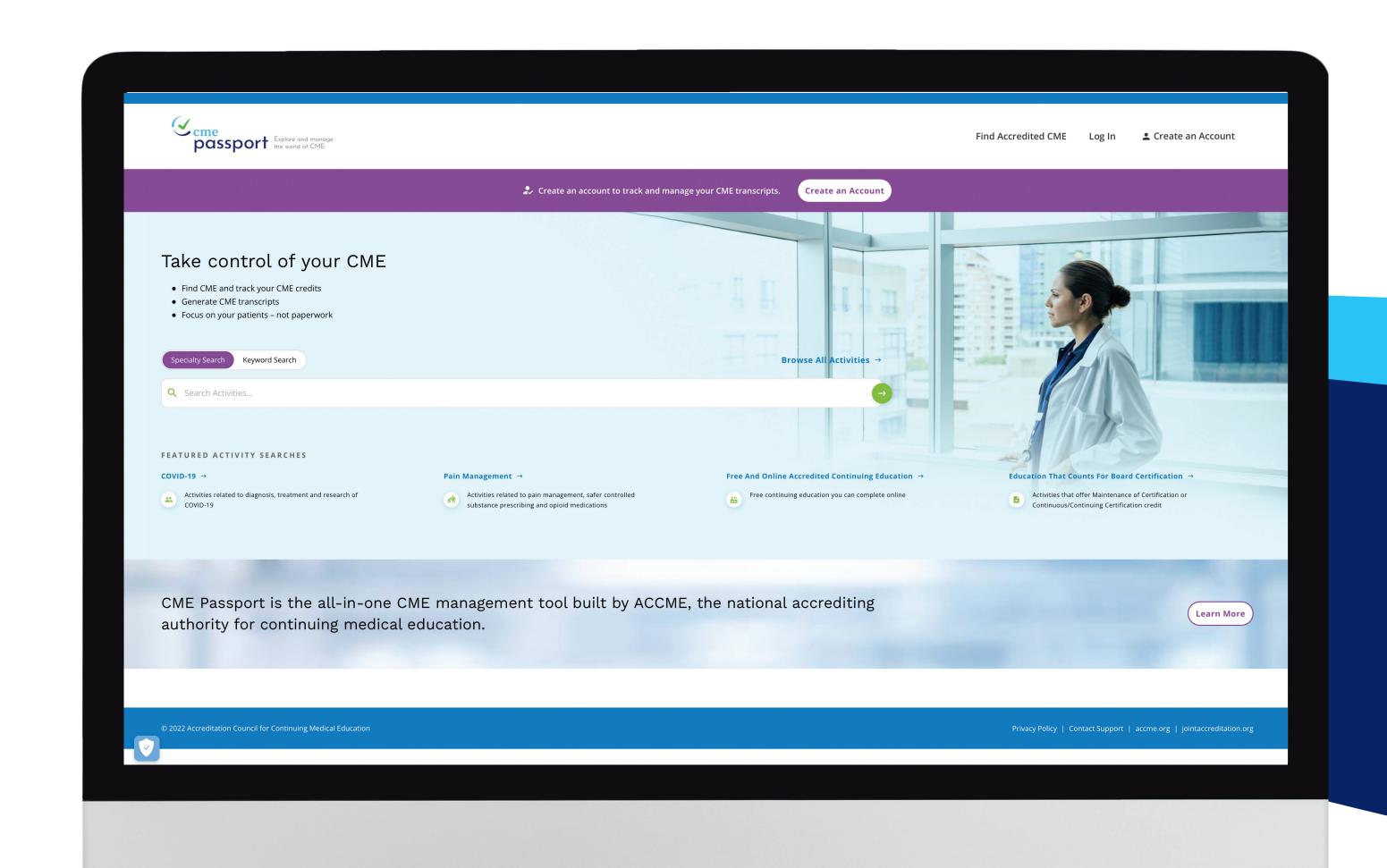

DIGITIZING THE CME VERIFICATION PROCESS

Join our growing collaboration of regulatory bodies! Any state medical licensing board can join the collaboration.

The Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME®) maintains an online data repository for all accredited CME activities.

This data repository has been expanded to allow electronic reporting of physicians' CME credit details by all accredited CME organizations.

An integrated, centralized data system is essential for reducing CME reporting burdens, and ACCME is uniquely positioned to lead this initiative.

CME credit details are made available to participating state medical licensing boards for the purpose of verifying CME credit required for:

- Re-licensure
- Remediation
- Restoration

The accredited CME organization enters data about an upcoming activity in PARS.



Licensees register to participate in the activity and comfirm their identity.



The accredited CME organization determines that the licensee has earned CME credit.



The accredited CME organization reports the CME credit data into PARS.



The Board can review the activity and CME completion data in PARS.

Leverage these Benefits of CME Passport for Your Licensing Board and Licensees:

- The review of licensees for having met re-licensure, remediation, or restoration requirements has been simplified.
- Electronic access means no paper to collect or review!
- You will have the ability to generate a printed version of physicians' CME transcripts.
- The system provides assurance that the CME credits reported for physicians are primary source verified, which contributes to the accountability of the licensing board to the public.
- It is a unified, digitized system for all state medical licensing boards to use for verifying the CME completion data of their licensees.
- Reporting burdens are reduced for licensed physicians.
- The data services and system are free of cost.
- Data is secure and not sold.
- CME Passport is a one-stop-shop for physicians to find CME as well as monitor their earned credits for CME and Maintenance of Certification/Continuing Certification (MOC/CC) for participating certifying boards.

CME PASSPORT BY THE NUMBERS

Since we opened CME reporting for all accredited CME organizations and all states:

- More than 23,000 accredited CME activities are currently listed.
- More than 21,000 new reports of CME credit earned have been entered.
- More than 100,000 additional AMA PRA Category 1™ credits have been reported.
- More than 1,000 additional accredited CME activities with CME credit have been reported.
- More than 200 additional accredited CME organizations are reporting CME credit.
- CME credit has been entered for 65 state medical licensing boards.
