
















- Richard E. Nisbett & Timothy DeCamp Wilson
- 1977 at the University of Michigan
- Interviews were stage with the same individual, a college instructor
- Warm and Friendly vs. Cold and Distant
- Warm = rated other domains positively
- Cold = rated other domains negatively
- People are attributing qualities that are not displayed across multiple domains
- They did not believe their dislike affected their rating of his attributes






Serial Position Primacy Effect







- Murdock, 1962
 - Primacy / Recency Effect
 - Earlier in the list = long-term memory
 - Last in the list = short-term member
- Glanzer and Cunitz, 1966
 - Primacy Effect is stronger
 - Count backwards in 3, recency effect disappears
 - Delayed recall decreases recency effect















