ICE – Incoming IJNs

- ICE will report to State TB Program where the facility is located
- Referring state will send documents provided by the ICE facility to receiving state
- Referring state will usually not request follow up information from receiving state
- Referring state will not always receive the final culture reports

ICE – Outgoing IJN

- For states with no ICE facilities, the most common outgoing IJN will be the Contact Investigation form
- Local jurisdiction reports dates and location of ICE facility to the state
- Referring state sends to IJN Coordinator in receiving state
- Referring state should call receiving state to ensure receipt
- Follow up results
