What is the Influence 100?



- A list of the largest membership organisations in the UK, ranked by total membership size.
- Today we launch the 6th Version created via:
 - > Desktop Primary Research
 - Input from the MemberWise Network Members
 - Direct approaches to member organisations
 - Data Collection Period: Feb 2024 April 2024



What has been achieved over the past 5 years?

- The most popular page on the MemberWise website
 - 500,000 visits since January 2019
- Many organisations displaying plaques in their HQs
- A sense of pride within many organisations
- Used by many to benchmark / research
- Celebrate size & scale of our sector
- Enabling unique benchmarking
- This year we again ensured the List is highly accurate









1) A headquarters based in the United Kingdom

2) Membership is optional and charged for directly via an annual membership fee

3) Over 50% of membership (voting members or equivalent) live or work in the UK





Caveats



- Data direct from member organisation staff and/or website
- Organisations produce annual total at different times of the year
- Desk research linked to published figures
- The information is correct as of April 2024
- The list will remain fixed until Jan 2025
- Updates can be submitted for 2025 List via info@memberwise.org.uk

Comparative Changes



- Last Year: 40,173,997 members in 2023/24 (0.13% increase)
- This Year: 39,749,700 members in 2023/24 (0.79% decrease)
- - 316,997 members



Notable Observations



- 46 organisations = Up / 37 organisations = Down
- 15 organisations = Remained the same
- 2 Organisations = New to the list
- Biggest ranking change:

Association of Accounting Technicians (AAT) (+ 11 entries)

- Largest increase is 153k (Unite)
- Largest decrease is 200k (National Union of Students)



Corporate List



- A dedicated list for membership bodies with the largest corporate schemes
- Last Year: 1,012,000 Members in 2023
- This Year: 965,000 members in 2024
- - 47,000 members
