

PROS:



Navigating Social Media Successfully

- Residents have lost jobs due to:
 - racist/inappropriate posts
 - endorsing products
- not representing the values of their institution

Applies to attending physicians as well

Navigating Social Media Successfully

- Abide by your institution's social media policy
- Post appropriately
 - -"would you want your mom or patient to see your post?"
- Post what you know: Stay within your realm of knowledge
- -study tips, application process, advice, etc



Navigating Other Media Opportunities Successfully

- Consider making your account private
- Get approval & notify superiors of media opportunities
- ▶ Be transparent; Never misrepresent yourself
 - Use "resident physician," or "3rd year med student"
- Have an attending review your work
- Support each other
