Here are the necessary steps to obtain your certificate after participating in a **live** webinar



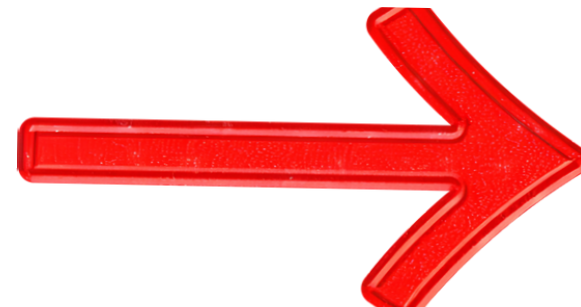


Step Two
