GROWTH

- How does birth weight change in the first few days after birth?
 - Weight loss of 5-10% in first 3 days
- What is expected weight gain in the first few weeks of life?
 - 20-30 g per day weight gain
- · By when should a baby regain birth weight?
 - by 2 weeks of age
- · By when does birth weight double?
 - Birth weight doubles by 6 months and triples by 1 year of age

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DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES

- At what age does an infant have a social smile?
 - 2 months
- At what age is finger grasp present?
 - 9 months
- At what age does a child walk?
 - 1 year of age
- At what age does a child have two-word sentences?
 - 2 years of age

VITAL SIGNS

- A heart rate above/below what values should be considered abnormal?
 - HR >180 should be considered abnormal
 - HR <60 should be considered abnormal
- A respiratory rate above/below what values should be considered abnormal?
 - RR > 60 should be considered abnormal
 - RR < 12 should be considered abnormal

VITAL SIGNS

- What is the formula for the minimal acceptable Systolic Blood Pressure in a child? (5th%)
 - •SBP = $70 + (2 \times age in years)$
 - Birth = SBP >60
 - Age > 10 years = SBP > 90
