



ACCME and State Medical Licensing Boards Collaboration

Below are some screenshots showing the licensee and CME activity data state medical licensing board staff can view in ACCME's Program and Activity Reporting System (PARS). Only CME credit that has been verified by the accredited education provider is able to be entered, so all data is primary source. At the end of the document, you will find screenshots of ACCME's public CME search tool, CME Passport. Physicians can also create a CME Passport account to track the CME that has been reported for them by accredited education providers.

Search for all licensees in a given timeframe – a variety of search filters are available to pare down results as desired. Board staff have numerous sorting options and can download either a full list or the filtered list of licensee credit details.



You can also search for CME credit reported for a particular licensee. This list can also be sorted and/or downloaded.



If you want to see summary data about the activities your licensees are participating in, you can do that as well. Filters, sorting options and downloads are also available for this data.




You can also view the details for a particular activity, including the activity description and other details entered by the CME provider.
