

AZA serves our members in advancing animal wellbeing, public engagement, and the conservation of wildlife and wild places, setting the global standard of excellence.






Professional Individual Membership Options


Student (\$40 or \$60 + Connect Subscription per calendar year)

- Students shall be individuals who are enrolled full-time or part-time as a student in a compulsory or higher education system.


Advocate Membership
