- Applying a consistent definition of substantial contributions per ICMJE criterion 1
- Documentation of the ICMJE criterion 1 contributions to the research/work
- Maintaining a consistent approach to selection of authors

Historical Perspective

GPP: 2003 First official publication (updated 2009, 2015, 2022) – follows ICMJE criteria for authorship

ICMJE: 1997 URM – includes "Acknowledgments" section

ICMJE: 1988 URM 3rd edition – "Each author should have participated sufficiently in the work to take public responsibility for the content" – first time the first 3 components of authorship appeared

ICMJE: 2004 URM -

"Writing and Editing for

Biomedical Publication"

in title; mentions both authorship and contributions in one

section

ICMJE: 2013 Update -

"Recommendations for the Conduct, Reporting, Editing, and Publication of Scholarly Work in Medical Journals"; Added 4th Authorship criteria and examples of "non-author contributors" ICMJE: 2021 Update – Last update primary focus is on Preprints

ICMJE: 1978 Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals (URM) 1st Ed. published – focused manuscript preparation







Why is Authorship Still an Issue for Publication Professionals Working in Pharma?

- Old habits are difficult to break
- Pub Professionals not always imbedded with clinical teams early on in research project
- Turnover

At ISMPP Meetings, challenges were identified resulting in the Authorship Task Force



ISMPP Authorship Algorithm

Authorship decisions are based on ICMJE criterion #1. Detailed guidance is needed for consistent and transparent use of ICMJE criterion #1 to ensure a fair and consistent author selection process

Define substantial contributions for authorship (ICMJE #1) for external and internal authors

Optimize documentation of contributions for contribution-based author selection

Increase transparency about authorship decisions

WG#1 Substantial Contributions

- Interpret substantial contributions for authorship
- Provide guidance on use of contributions for author selection

WG#2 Documentation

- Develop tool to facilitate documentation and scoring of contributions
- Provide guidance on handling authorship disputes, author order and number

WG#3 Transparency

 Develop communication & education plan for external stakeholders

WG#4 Communication

 Develop and execute communication strategy

What are substantial intellectual contributions?

Study concept or design

- Conceptualizing, refining, and/or modifying a research^a idea and/or a design such as:
 - Identifying unmet need or scientific knowledge gap (i.e. rationale)
 - Framing the research question
 - Identifying the research procedures or techniques

And/Or

 Significant intellectual input into development or modification of the protocol and/or methodology (e.g. inclusion/exclusion criteria, selection of outcome measures), and/or statistical analysis plan (e.g. selection of statistical tests/analyses)

Or Data acquisition

- Contributing most data with high quality^b to the final analyses such as:
 - Numbers of participants (enrolled, randomized, or retained) relative to the total number of participants, or
 - Generation of other types of data (e.g. database analyses)

Or Data analysis

 Performing the analyses, interpreting the output in the context of the specific research objectives, and ensuring integrity and accuracy of the data

Or Data interpretation

 Interpreting the overall study/research, results, deliberating on the strengths and limitations of the design or methodology, supporting/ critiquing key observations and deriving conclusions

And/Or

- Contextualizing the results based on published literature/advances in the field such as:
 - Deriving clinical implications
 - Providing insights on real-world experiences
- Identifying knowledge gaps for further exploration

^aResearch includes clinical, pre-clinical, and translational studies, inclusive of primary, secondary, and exploratory analyses, as well as health outcomes and real-world evidence. ^bQuality refers to meeting the protocol-defined requirements for primary and secondary analyses (e.g. complete data set with minimal missing data or errors).



What are *not* substantial intellectual contributions?

Study concept or design

- Review/approval of study synopsis / concept sheet, protocol, statistical analysis plan without provision of input that influences the research
- Oversight and/or managerial responsibility (e.g. lab head, site institution head)
- Writing the protocol or clinical study report
- Literature search
- Membership in Steering Committees or Advisory Boards
- Funding acquisition

Or Data acquisition

- Study site activation, site monitoring, checking GCP compliance, data entry, query management
- Data collection without intellectual input following a standard process, data quality monitoring/ assurance, data cleaning, data validation, programming
- Database management, data handling, data storage, sample handling, sample management
- Providing instrumentation, software, technology

Or Data analysis

- Programming output tables, writing codes, data management
- Quality control, validation
- Oversight and/or managerial responsibility (e.g. team lead)

Or Data interpretation

- Literature searches, reference compilation
- · Editorial assistance
- Compiling submission package/submission





Recommendations - Summary

- Facilitate an author selection process grounded in the core principles of substantial intellectual contribution
 - to the work's conception or design, or to the acquisition, analysis, or interpretation of data
- Focus on author selection practices for industry-sponsored research prior to the start of a study/publication
 - they may be applied to publications in other areas of scientific and biomedical research
- Consistent adoption into company process and culture is key to ensure uniform approaches for authorship decisions
- Served as a basis for the ISMPP Authorship Algorithm Tool
 - to facilitate uniform application and documentation of contributions
